## General Playing Rules:

- Standard USAPA rules apply.
- Communicate clearly and quickly with line calls.
- Communicate in a clear and timely fashion if a ball interferes from another court, which results in a replay.
- Ceiling, basketball hoops/extensions, walls, etc... are considered out. Side bleachers at Sunrise are considered out unless the ball was playable in which case a replay will occur.
- Flip a coin to determine serve or side.
- Announce the score loudly before serving.
- One timeout per game per team.
- A high degree of sportsmanship is required. Failure to show good sportsmanship can result in expulsion from the tournament.


## Pool Play Games:

- Pool Play matches will be one game to 15 points win by one, switch sides at 8 .


## Tournament:

- Single elimination tournament with a third-place match.
- Teams will be seeded according to their pool play standings after pool play. For some divisions there will be a gold, silver and even bronze bracket. Ties will be broken by the following methods:
- First- Who won when they played head to head during pool play.
- Secondly-Point differential between the tied teams when they played head to head during pool play.
- Lastly- Point differential in all pool play games.
- Tournament matches will be best 2 out of 3 , play to 11 , win by two, switch sides at 6 in the third set if needed, except for third place game which will be one game to 15 , win by two, switch sides at 8 .
